



## **IRB Statement of Compliance**

Written standard operating procedures govern IntegReview for initial, expedited and continuing review of clinical research studies. Written minutes of convened meetings are retained in compliance with the applicable federal regulations and ICH Guidelines for Good Clinical Practices, E6.
